THE AWARDS

Awards will be presented in the following categories:

-  Business




AREAS OF FOCUS

Focus of projects may include:

-  Litter Prevention/Removal
-  Community Improvement
-  Neighborhood Beautification
-  Recycling Waste Reduction

ELIGIBILITY

To enter:

-  Individuals must be residents of Hillsborough County.
-  Businesses & Groups must be located within Hillsborough County.
-  Projects must be completed or ongoing during 2008-2009 .

JUDGING

The staff of Keep Hillsborough County Beautiful will choose the finalists for each award, and the board of directors will vote on one winner from each category.

PRESENTATION OF AWARDS

The presentation of awards will be made at the awards luncheon in **Friday, August 7, 2009**.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

All applications must be returned no later than **Friday, July 17, 2009**. Any application not meeting the deadline will be automatically disqualified.
